Traffic Alert

North Rillito Interceptor (NRI) Sewer Rehabilitation Project

This is a series of traffic alerts that will be issued throughout the construction of the North Rillito Interceptor (NRI) Sewer Rehabilitation Project. These alerts will announce construction, detour and street closure information as it affects residents, businesses and traffic within the area. The 10-mile long NRI project is being completed in phases; the current phase is bounded on the north by River Road, the south by the Rillito River, the east by Craycroft Road and the west by Swan Road. However, there may be times when construction impacts are located outside these general boundaries.

On Monday, April 13 2015 the contractor will begin the process of installing the sewer bypass system which must be in place prior to rehabilitation work beginning on the sewer interceptor lines. The following traffic control will be in place through the middle of May 2015:

- Traffic along north and southbound Craycroft Road, between River Road and The Gregory traffic signal, will be shifted to the east side of the road way.
- Two northbound and two southbound travel lanes will be maintained.
- Travel lanes will be reduced to ten-foot widths.
- Turn movements at the intersection of River and Craycroft Roads will not be affected.
- Access to The Gregory School and Castlehill Country Day School will be maintained at all
- All turn movements at The Gregory traffic signal will be permitted.
- This traffic control will remain in place 24-hours per day through the middle of May 2015.

Traffic control along the shoulder/bike lane of southbound (west side) Craycroft Road, between River Road and The Gregory traffic signal, will remain in place through August 2015. For additional information or to view detailed maps of the area, visit
