Traffic Alert
North Rillito Interceptor (NRI)
Relief Project

This is a series of traffic alerts that will be issued throughout the construction of the North Rillito Interceptor (NRI) Relief Project. These alerts will announce construction, detour and street closure information as it affects residents, businesses and traffic within the area. The Relief project will connect the North Rillito Interceptor and the South Rillito Interceptor in the area of Columbus Boulevard.

Beginning the week of August 10, 2015, the contractor will repair/replace sidewalk and curb along Greenlee Road and Columbus Boulevard.

- The sidewalk along the north side of Greenlee Road will be closed between Columbus Boulevard and Lazy Day Drive.
- The sidewalk along the east side of Columbus Boulevard will be closed between Greenlee Road and the north end of Columbus Boulevard.
- The sidewalk along the west side of Columbus Boulevard will be closed between Sapphire Falls and the north end of Columbus Boulevard.

Beginning the week of August 17, 2015, the contractor will pave and re-stripe Columbus Boulevard from the Greenlee Road intersection north to the end of the roadway.

- Columbus Boulevard will be closed from Greenlee Road north to the end of the roadway.
- Motorists traveling through the intersection of Greenlee Road and Columbus Boulevard will be shifted to accommodate paving operations. Flaggers may be on sight to help direct traffic through the intersection.
- Paradise Falls Drive and Sapphire Falls Drive will be closed at their intersections with Columbus Boulevard.
- Roadway striping will occur as soon as paving is complete.
- All roadways will be reopened to the public when paving and striping has been completed.
