

TRAFFIC ALERT
Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department
Tucson Boulevard Diversion Structure Rehabilitation

Hunter Contracting Company, under contract with the Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department, have begun installing a temporary above-ground sewer bypass system. This work is in preparation for a sewer improvements project to replace the existing diversion structure located at the north end of Tucson Boulevard. The traveling public will see equipment, above ground pipes, work crews and placement of traffic control during this phase of work.

Replacing the diversion structure will require removing (bypassing) the wastewater flows from the sewer pipes that run along Tucson Boulevard between Prince Road and Roger Road. There will also be several other sewer infrastructure replacements/improvements in this area during this project.

The traveling public should anticipate the following traffic restrictions:

Beginning at 7 a.m. on Wednesday, March 30, westbound Prince Road will be reduced to one through travel lane, with westbound motorists shifted into the center turn lane, from just east of Tucson Blvd. to Jackson Avenue. This lane restriction will remain in place through August 2022.

- North and southbound turn movements will not be restricted, however, there will not be dedicated turn lanes.
- Access to residential streets and neighborhoods will be maintained.

This traffic/lane restriction is necessary to accommodate pipes and equipment that will be used while the sewer bypass is in operation.
