TRAFFIC ALERT

Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department Tucson Boulevard Diversion Structure Rehabilitation

April 13, 2022

Hunter Contracting Company, under contract with the Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department, has completed the installation of the temporary above-ground sewer bypass system along Prince Road and a portion of Jackson Avenue. The bypass is in preparation for a sewer improvements project to replace an existing diversion structure located at the north end of Tucson Boulevard. The traveling public will see equipment, above ground pipes, work crews, and traffic control during this improvement project.

The traveling public should anticipate the following upcoming traffic restrictions:

From 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Thursday, April 14 and Friday, April 15, the contractor will install approximately 400 feet of temporary pavement along the east shoulder of Tucson Boulevard, from Roger Road south to the entrance of Gentleman's Acres. Flaggers will be on site to help direct traffic safely around the paving operation.

This temporary pavement is being installed to provide vehicular access during the scheduled mainline sewer improvements and will be removed when the project is complete.

Currently, westbound Prince Road is reduced to one through travel lane, with westbound motorists shifted into the center turn lane, from just east of Tucson Boulevard to Jackson Avenue. This lane restriction will remain in place through August 2022.

- North and southbound turn movements will not be restricted, however, there will not be dedicated turn lanes.
- Access to residential streets and neighborhoods will be maintained.

This traffic/lane restriction is necessary to accommodate pipes and equipment that will be used while the sewer bypass is in operation.
