**Continental Ranch Regional Pump Station
Force Main Augmentation Project**

In November the contractor will begin installing new dual 24-inch pipelines from the Continental Ranch Regional Pump Station, ultimately heading southward along the west bank of the Santa Cruz River – and tying-in to the completed segment south of the Crossroads at Silverbell District Park (between Cortaro and Ina roads).

During the week of November 14, 2022, Borderland Construction, under contract with Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department, will begin work in the area of the Continental Ranch Regional Pump Station (CRRPS) located off North Coachline Boulevard. This work is in advance of trenching activities for pipe installation that are currently scheduled to begin during the week of November 21, 2022. ([see map for more details](#))

- There will be a couple days when a portion of the Chuck Huckelberry Loop (the Loop) will be intermittently closed while the contractor installs pipe across the pathway. The impacted section of the Loop travels along the south side of the El Rio Preserve just north of the CRRPS.

Trenching activities will continue eastward to the area of the new Santa Cruz River bank-protection near El Rio Preserve, they will then head southward toward Twin Peaks Road generally following the Loop alignment. *There will be extensive construction activity during this phase of work.* Construction of this phase is scheduled for mid-December 2022 through mid-May 2023.

- Residents whose properties back up to the Loop should expect weekday construction activity – generally from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Portions of the Loop will be closed to all pedestrian and bicycle traffic (see map on reverse for closed areas).

When complete, the project will provide seven miles of a new dual force main sewer system between the Continental Ranch Regional Pump Station (CRRPS), and the Tres Ríos Water Reclamation Facility (WRF). The Loop travelers will also enjoy a newly paved pathway that will be installed from the El Rio Preserve area to Cortaro Road.

Emergency access will always be provided.
