<u>Purpose</u>

- Increase Capacity of Sewer Along 22nd Street Between Alvernon & Swan Roads
- Replace 60 year old Water Main Within the Intersection of Alvernon & 22nd Street



What is the Project?


Main Tasks

- 190' of 36" water main replacement at Alvernon & 22nd St
- Install new maintenance access vault for area water mains
- Install 5,376' of new 12" sewer pipe
- Remove 1,933' of aging 8" sewer pipe
- Rehabilitation of the existing 10" sewer
- Mill & Overlay roadway upon completion
