Traffic Alert

North Rillito Interceptor (NRI) Sewer Rehabilitation Project

A series of traffic alerts will be issued throughout the construction of the North Rillito Interceptor (NRI) Sewer Rehabilitation Project. These alerts will announce construction, detour and street closure information as it affects residents, businesses and traffic within the area. The 10-mile long NRI project is being completed in phases; the current phase's construction boundaries are along River Road from Palo Verde to just west of Campbell Avenue.

On Sunday, February 28 the contractor will begin placing traffic control along River Road, between Roger Road and Hacienda Del Sol. The traffic control will remain in place until the Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) sewer rehabilitation is complete. The lining operations are expected to be complete by mid-March 2016.

The following restrictions will be in place during the work:

- Traffic will be shifted around the work areas.
- Two lanes in each direction will be maintained.
- Left-turns (eastbound travel) at Camino Kino will be intermittently restricted to accommodate work in the area.
- Left-turns (eastbound travel) at Camino Boscaje Escondido will be intermittently restricted to accommodate shifted traffic and work in the area.

Motorists traveling through the area should expect delays. Bicyclists and pedestrians should use caution when riding/walking through the area.
