Traffic Alert 22nd Street Sewer Augmentation Project Swan Road to Alvernon Way

The following traffic control will be in place while the contractor installs new sewer lines and repaves portions of the roadway through the intersection of **22nd Street and Columbus Boulevard**. To reduce the impact on the traveling public, most trenching, excavation and pipe installation work will be completed over night. However, some daytime lane restrictions will remain in place in order to complete the paving operations.

NOTICE: There will not be any night work performed on Wednesday, May 4. The work originally scheduled for Wednesday night will be rescheduled for a later date.

Daytime Traffic Restrictions

Thursday, May 5, 2016 from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m. (Longfellow Avenue to Columbus Boulevard)

- Westbound 22nd Street will be reduced to two through-travel lanes
- Right turn movements along westbound 22nd Street are unrestricted
- Left turn movements along westbound and eastbound 22nd Street will have intermittent restrictions as the contractor completes sewer installation at each median crossover/left-turn lane

Thursday, May 5, 2016 from 5 a.m. to noon

- Eastbound 22nd Street at the intersection of Swan Road will be reduced to two travel lanes while the contractor completes investigative (potholing) work in the intersection.
- Eastbound right turn movements from 22nd Street to southbound Swan Road will not be permitted.

Business access will be maintained at all times

Bicyclists should use caution while traveling through the area and/or use alternate routes if possible

For your safety, please observe all traffic control signage, message boards and obey reduced speed limits. Watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone.
