Traffic Alert 22nd Street Sewer Augmentation Project Swan Road to Alvernon Way

This is a series of traffic alerts that will be issued throughout the construction of the 22nd Street Sewer Augmentation Project. These alerts will announce construction, detour and street closure information as it affects traffic. Please watch for updated traffic alerts as construction activities continue along 22nd Street from Swan Road to Alvernon Way.

The following traffic restrictions will be in place while the contractor completes potholing activities:

Friday, August 5, from 9 a.m. to Noon

- Westbound 22nd Street at the Alvernon Way intersection will be reduced to two through-travel lanes
- Left-turn movements will be reduced to one lane from westbound 22nd Street to southbound Alvernon Way
- Northbound Alvernon Way at the 22nd Street intersection will be reduced to one through-travel lane

The following traffic restrictions will be in place while the contractor completes paving activities:

Beginning at 10 p.m. on Sunday, August 7 through Noon on Monday, August 8

- Westbound 22nd Street from Swan Road to Longfellow Avenue will be **reduced to one through-travel lane**
- All left-turn movements will be restricted at the intersection of 22nd Street and Columbus Boulevard
- There will be **intermittent closures** for northbound and southbound through traffic on Columbus Boulevard at 22nd Street **when paving equipment moves through the intersection and while the asphalt cures**
- There will be intermittent median closures at Longfellow Avenue on 22nd Street
- Left turn movements along westbound and eastbound 22nd Street between Swan Road and Longfellow Avenue will be restricted at each median crossover/left-turn lane

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The following traffic restrictions will be in place while the contractor completes manhole adjustment activities:

Beginning at 5 a.m. on Wednesday, August 10 through 3 p.m. on Friday, August 12

• Westbound 22nd Street between Swan Road and Longfellow Avenue will be reduced to two through-lanes.

Following the above detailed work, <u>there will be no construction related activities until</u> <u>environmental clearance has been received</u>. After clearance is received, the contractor will complete the relocation of a 6-inch waterline along 22nd Street at Longfellow Avenue. The final paving of all disturbed construction areas is scheduled for completion by the end of September, weather permitting.

For your safety, please observe all traffic control signage, message boards and obey reduced speed limits. Watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone.
