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**Traffic Alert**  
**22<sup>nd</sup> Street Sewer Rehabilitation Project**  
**Swan Road to Alvernon Way**

This is the first in a series of traffic alerts that will be issued throughout the construction of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Street Sewer Rehabilitation Project. These alerts will announce construction, detour and street closure information as it affects traffic.

The contractor will begin pothole operations, a non-invasive procedure to help identify underground utility locations, in preparation of the upcoming sewer rehabilitation along 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, from Swan Road to Alvernon Way. In an effort to minimize impact to the traveling public, the contractor will work during the over-night hours of 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning (this work will take place one night only). This phase of work will be centered in the intersection of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Alvernon Way.

The following restriction will be in place:

- Eastbound 22<sup>nd</sup> Street will be reduced to two-through travel lanes and right turns only. LEFT turns will not be permitted.
- Westbound 22<sup>nd</sup> Street will be reduced to one left turn lane, one-through travel lane and right turns.
- Southbound Alvernon Way will be reduced to one left turn lane, one-through travel lane and right turns.
- Northbound Alvernon Way will be reduced to one left turn lane, one-through travel lane and right turns.

The above restrictions will be in place Thursday evening, September 17, 2015.

The traveling public should expect delays when driving, bicycling, or walking in this work area. For your safety, please observe all traffic control signage, message boards and obey reduced speed limits. Watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone.
