Traffic Alert
22nd Street Sewer Augmentation Project
Swan Road to Alvernon Way

This is a series of traffic alerts that will be issued throughout the construction of the 22nd Street Sewer Augmentation Project. These alerts will announce construction, detour and street closure information as it affects traffic.

The following traffic control will be in place while the contractor completes sidewalk and curb installation and manhole adjustments along 22nd Street and in the 22nd Street/Alvernon Way intersection. While this work is completed, various travel lanes will be closed for 24-hour-periods to allow time for concrete to cure before the travel lane is re-opened to traffic.

6 a.m. to 3 p.m. Friday, September 30, 2016

- The outside curb lane of **westbound 22nd Street from Bryant Avenue to Longfellow** will be closed while the contractor installs curb, sidewalk and driveway aprons. **All side street access** will be maintained during this work

9 a.m. Monday, October 3 through 2 p.m. Tuesday, October 4, 2016

- Left-turn movements from **westbound 22nd Street to southbound Alvernon way** will be reduced to one turn-lane while the contractor completes utility adjustments in the intersection and to allow time for the concrete to cure.

7 a.m. to 2 p.m. Friday, October 7, 2016

- The inside median-lane of westbound 22nd Street from Swan Road to Alvernon Way will be closed while project inspections are conducted along the roadway. All turn movements will be maintained.

NOTE: Upcoming work at the intersection of Alvernon Way and 22nd Street will require overnight restrictions to all left-turn movements while the contractor installs a survey monument in the center of the intersection. Please watch for advance notice of this restriction.

For your safety, please observe all traffic control signage, message boards and obey reduced speed limits. Watch for construction personnel and equipment in the work zone.
