

# Mabel Street Sewer and Treatment Project

**Your property** is in an area where the Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department (RWRD) and its contractor, Hunter Contracting Co., are beginning work on the Mabel Street Sewer Improvement Project located near Pima Community College (PCC) Downtown Campus. This project addresses capacity concerns which were identified in the Speedway Sewer Augmentation Study.

The improvements will occur along Mabel Street between Sixth and Thirteenth avenues (see map on reverse side). The contractor will install new twelve-inch diameter sewer mains from Tenth Avenue to Thirteenth Avenue, replace the existing eight-inch diameter sewer lines with new twelve-inch lines from Sixth Avenue to Tenth Avenue and install approximately ten new sixty-inch diameter manholes.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early August 2020 and is expected to be completed fall of 2020.

To lessen the impact on the traveling public, the contractor plans to use a **jack and bore operation** to cross Stone Avenue. **Jack and bore** is a method of horizontal construction where construction crews drill a hole underground horizontally between two points without disturbing the surface.

Because of COVID-19, a Public Open House is not possible. Team members will be available to talk individually with you about your access and any other project related questions you may have.
